The dead of winter Winter mortality will never be eliminated; it's nature's way of ensuring that only the strongest of the species survive to reproduce Winter survival is determined by the availability of high quality fall food (to ensure fat accumulation) and winter thermal cover (to conserve energy)

Anatomy of Grapevine Winter Injury and Recovery

This section shows a small sector that was freeze-injured in winter after the first growing season The inner, first-season xylem ring is OK but shows dead tissue just outside it Thus, the cambium and phloem was injured Note that after callus production and vascular "recovery" the second year, a significant sector of new xylem is still
